
Our Prez Lou Morsch presented with The Judith Goadby Award for 2014.



REF'S CORNER

A few tips for all markers (according to the rules of squash).

- 1. Be audible (What's that you say?).
- The correct call for an incorrect serve is "Fault" (not out or high ball or anything else). This a new change to the rules of squash.
- 3. One all, seven all (not one **togethe**r or seven **together** etc. etc.)
- 4. Ball hitting the tin is **down.**
- 5. **Not up** is the correct call for a double bounce or if a shot is deemed to have been carried off the racket. (not **double**)
- 6. The correct call after the score reaches 8 all is set one or set two

NINE years ago in Ballarat a fifteen year old apprentice carpenter started playing squash, very quickly became addicted and embarked on a lone campaign to master the game. Consequently, in 1975, quietly spoken Tom Spark, having got himself a vehicle, travelled weekly to Melbourne and played Sunday "A" Grade for Keon Park. The team comprised Tom, Bruce Turner, Gary McIntosh, Gordon Laurie and Jack Morrell (the mentor of the group). Success graced the combination, but upon winning the pennant, Tom retired to Ballarat for two more years.

In 1978, Bruce Turner invited Tom to play mid week and an unknown entity to State First Grade, Tom commenced playing for Northcote as the team's No. 4. Dubbed "the unknown Ballarat electriclan" (although now a carpenter), Tom proceeded to embarrass numerous established First Grade players who underestimated him. His performances for the season were excellent and he was promoted to No. 2 in the team.

Tom turned professional in 1979 and carried his quiet dedication into coaching at Ballarat. Would-be pupils are, however, currently deferring their demands upon Tom's attention. His own game is improving so much that he is concentrating on further individual development. This has required consistent dedication, considerable time and many hours of travelling as Tom is very attached to living in Ballarat, having been a resident there since he was five years old.

The Ballarat Community Squash Association, of which Tom is an active member, are justifiably proud of his achievements and so far this year (1980) he has won the Mountain District, Monash University and Western Victorian championships. His home town's own championship has narrowly eluded him although certainly not due to any lack of local support. Tom has obtained a State No. 1 pennant spot and Victorian representation is his immediate aspiration for 1981.


Tom sets an excellent example to all with his court demeanour and training discipline. Of necessity, he has had to virtually teach himself from books and by lone practise, but is quick to appreciatively refer to the help, advice and encouragement received from other players, his Ballarat colleagues and his wife, Chris.

Such notables as the friends made in that first season of 1975 get mentioned, but observers note that his style is individually distinctive and bears no resemblance to any of these gentlemen.

As a coach passing on advice, Tom recommends players seeking improvement should listen, read and experiment gradually, compiling their own effective style adhering to the basic requirement of returning everything and making no mistakes. The development of shots to be winners or to apply additional pressure on your opponent can then follow, but Tom believes that many a match has been unnecessarily lost by the playing of winning shots. Above all, Tom emphasises the fact that one must seek out hard competition regardless of how uncomfortable additice, all of which has worked for Tom, so maybe it's worth a try.

How much longer Tom can continue to live in Ballarat and pursue his squash aspirations from there, remains to be seen, because the better he gets the more inconsistent these two things become. Although migrating to Melbourne temporarily doesn't excite either Tom or Chris, it is quite probable that they may soon make the move and established players here will have their work cut out to keep the "Ballarat Electician" out of contention.

Outside squash, Tom is at present a trade teaching assistant and leads a quiet life in Ballarat except when Melbourne friends ascend for the weekend. Being a Ballarat boy to the core, Tom believes he is only the first of many good players who will eminate from that city and, observing the development of squash in Ballarat, one has no cause to doubt this.

- Notice of withdrawal and request for refund should be made to the Tournament Director 7 days prior to tournament start date. No refunds will be made after this date at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
