VICTORIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS — DROMANA

Now our next tournament, the Victorian Championships, is being held at **Dromana** again this year.

As the results for this tournament help to determine your ranking for the Australian Championships that are being held in Hobart in September, it is in your best interest to enter.

It will be played in 5 year age brackets, ie 35-39, 40-44 etc Men and Women.

There will be Open and graded events depending on entry numbers. Scoring will be PAR15 for all grades/divisions.



PENNANT REPORT - Jill Morsch

Hopefully after that hiccup, it is onwards without too many other dramas for the rest of the season. My thanks to Mike, Clara, Bryan and new recruit Ian Wyatt for volunteering their time to get everything in place for the season to commence on time, keeping me posted on what was eventuating and taking on board my thoughts on matters at hand whilst I was dealing with concerns of my Dad's health.

PENNANT REPORT *Cont'd*

The grading of pennant teams is a very difficult issue. Trust me - we do not deliberately put you into a grade you believe is unsuitable for you (yet again as some may think). Whilst I am sympathetic to people/teams/clubs grievances, please remember we are trying to do the best we can for ALL people/teams/clubs not just your club or your team. On most occasions when we are grading teams there are some very tough decisions to make on who goes up or not and at times we are nearly pulling our hair out trying to get the balance right. Sometimes we may have to push a team into a grade where they may not be fully competitive, but we have to choose which team and it's personnel we believe will handle it the best.

One of the reasons people love playing masters is to be able to play as a team with their mates or family. There may be wide differences in standards of players so your club along with the VMSA try to work out the best grade for you and that too causes many headaches for the match and pennant committee.

I am hoping you can all take my remarks about pennant on board and not take it personally if we have not put you into the grade you would prefer. Try to understand we have tried to make every grade evenly competitive with an equal chance for any team to win a grand final. Also remember that there are 5 of us on match and pennant who get together to do the gradings. We ALL discuss and collectively agree on matters regarding grading, penalties and disciplinary issues without bias.

Speaking about disciplinary matters, if you wish to place a report about player misbehaviour, there is now a link on the home page of the VMSA website under "Quick Links" where you can download a disciplinary report form. Just download it, fill it out and email it to me. Please make sure you get the report to me ASAP so I can investigate any claims then discuss with Mike, Ian & Lou what action needs to be taken. This all needs to be done before the next pennant round. Remember that a good way to prevent bad behaviour on the court is by way of firm refereeing. Further measures are the issuing of conduct warnings where appropriate or conduct points and if bad behaviour continues after these steps then a conduct game or match. If the last 2 steps are taken, then a report must be sent to me for us to deal further with this problem.

As your newly elected Pennant Director, I have to thank our President, Lou Morsch for his support. He has taking the pressure off me by dealing with some letters of complaint directed towards the match & pennant committee whilst I have been focussing on my dad's health. For those of you who know my dad, Gerry Mahon is a past VMSA Pennant Director as well as squash pennant player and Tournament Director. Dad suffered a slight bleed to the brain just after the New Year and has been in hospital/rehab for just over a month. He is now out and resting at one of my sibling's place as he tries to regain some strength and hopefully improve on his short term memory that has been affected. Unfortunately this has knocked him around a bit and we have all been affected by seeing him as frail as he is because he has always been so sharp & active. Even at the ripe old age of 91 he was still driving and enjoying playing lawn bowls. So please keep him in your prayers as we wish him a full recovery.

I have gone on a bit, but I really hope that everyone now understands a little bit more about the issues surrounding pennant. It is not as easy to grade teams as we all think, but we do try to make it as painless as possible.

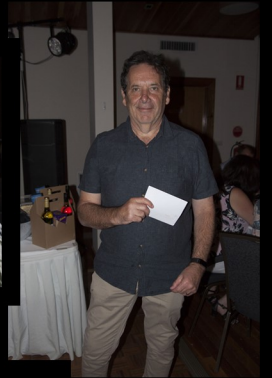

Members ensure club is prepared for action

HOURS upon hours of hard work by Horsham Squash club members have it well prepared to host more than 100 players for the Victorian Masters Squash Association tournament over the weekend.

The tournament has attracted entrants from across Victoria, Tasmania and from as far as Western Australia.

Club president Chris Warrick said the tournament would be a great opportunity for club members to see play of a higher standard.

"Typically we've hosted some regional events but this is the first time, certainly that I'm aware of, that we've hosted a state event like this," he said.

"Seeing as it's an open tournament people from around here will be playing as well and that is a great opportunity for them.

"To be able to get amongst it all is an opportunity in itself for our members to improve their own games."

The tournament is the first of six Victorian Masters Squash Association tournaments of the year and is open to all players over the age of 35.

The team event will be followed by tournaments in April, May, July, September and November.

The other aspect that had really excited Warrick was how the club has rallied together to prepare for the high profile tournament.

"The club members have put in a huge amount of work over the past weeks and months to make sure everything is ready," he said.

"It's been a really positive community atmospheres and supportive environment down there lately.

"That's not something I'd really considered at the start, but throughout the planning I've seen how strong the club really is and how good our people are.

"It's good to see our facilities being utilised and keen members down there running the club."

Countless hours had been put in doing a variety of maintenance at the club in that time.

"People have been coming down to clean, to fit new light and fans, do electrical work and to paint," Warrick said.

"Other people have been organising store rooms and the room to cater for more people as well as all the food and drink.

"It's been a huge amount of work but it hasn't just been a few people doing a heap of work, it's everyone doing a bit each."

The tournament will run from Friday evening to Sunday afternoon with anyone interested invited to attend.

"It will just be a great chance to see some good quality squash first-hand," Warrick said.

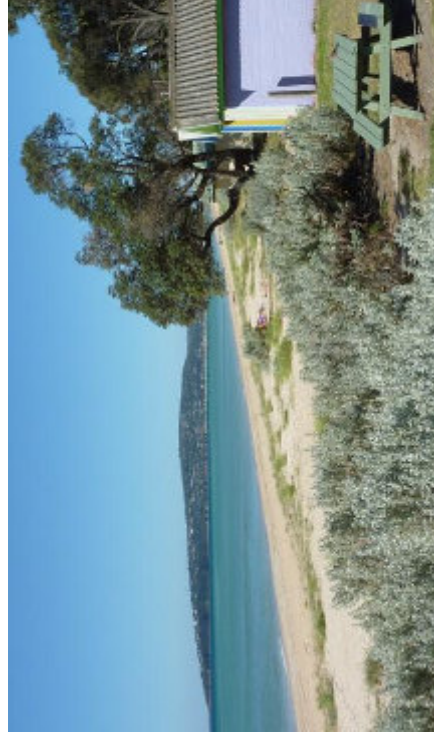
