Pennant Report – Jill Morsch

By the time the newsletter is out, finals for our 2018 Autumn Pennant will be completed. Congratulations and commiserations to all teams who competed in the finals. I trust that as always, matches were played in the right competitive Masters spirit and thanks and hospitality was extended to referees and markers who assisted on the night

A reminder that team submissions for the next pennant season must be received to our results Officer, Clara Edney, by **22nd June**. That way, we can complete gradings and pass them to Bryan Bird in order to get the fixture in place for next season.

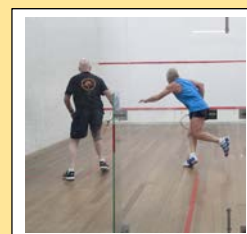
The VMSA match and pennant committee have not organized a refereeing clinic for some time. In fact, we believe the last one was in 2008. We have decided to conduct one next season on Thursday July 26, which would normally be set down for the pennant co-ordinators meeting (one week prior to commencement of the new season). Like the last time we ran one, it is compulsory for at least 4 members of your team to attend this clinic and it will count as premiership points to your team. *Any less than 4 team members will result in no premiership points to your team*. The clinic will be conducted at the following venues – Westerfolds, Mulgrave and Squash Logic commencing at 7.30pm. Teams can choose which venue they wish to attend. Before you say “we have already attended a refereeing clinic with another pennant association” – it is irrelevant. It is compulsory to attend ours in order to receive premiership points. Please make sure you arrive early as you will be marked off as you enter the centre and this may take some time. Do not get someone else to mark you off as it will not be accepted – YOU must present yourself to the VMSA committee person who will record your attendance at your venue of choice. You must also stay for the entire presentation.

Teams will also be able to collect their fixture books on the night. You will also be receiving a questionnaire as to which scoring method you prefer for pennant going forward. The choice will be best of 5 games to 9 points, hand in/hand out or best of 5 games to 15 points, point a rally and to win by 2 clear points if scores reach 14 all. This is being done because we are hearing different views as to what point scoring system players prefer. In the past it was raised as a team question. This is your chance, as an individual, to put pen to paper and let us know once & for all what your preference is. From the answers we receive, the scoring preference of the majority will be implemented for the 2019 Autumn pennant season and beyond.

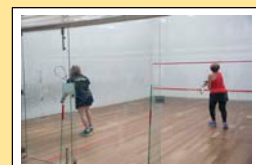
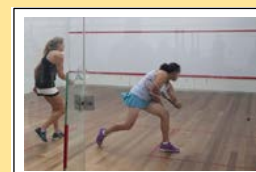
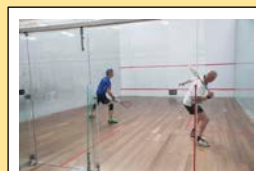
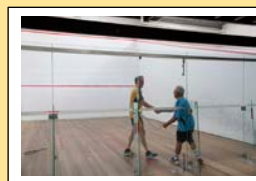
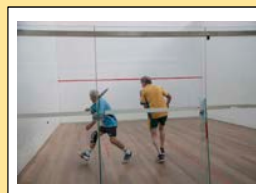

1. The tournament will be conducted using triple plate or round robin draws depending on number of entries received. Every effort will be made to ensure that each entrant gets at least three matches.
2. **PLAYERS MUST FULFIL THEIR OBLIGATIONS TO OTHER PARTICIPANTS BY COMPETING IN ALL MATCHES SET DOWN FOR THEM.**
3. **Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or not accept entrants and to re-grade any entries.**
4. Notice of withdrawal and request for refund should be made to the Tournament Director 7 days prior to the tournament start date. No refunds will be made after this date at the discretion of the tournament committee.
5. No claims whatsoever will be recognized should any player receive an injury whilst participating in the tournament.
6. **For advice of first round matches, please check on our website: www.vmsasquash.com.au from Wednesday 18th July 2018.**
7. Players must report to Tournament Control no later than **30 MINUTES BEFORE** their next scheduled match.
8. All players will be expected to be warmed up and ready to play as soon as the previous match is completed.
9. All players will be expected to mark or referee the match immediately following their own, or as directed by the tournament control.
10. Trophy presentations will be at approximately 4:30pm Sunday followed by a complimentary supper.
11. A social get-together, including complimentary supper will be held at the Goulburn Valley Squash Centre on Friday evening 20th July after the conclusion of the matches. ALL WELCOME
