Next we go to Shepparton.


The dinner dance will be held at a new venue, Quality Hotel Parklake. 481 Wyndham Street, Shepparton.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Pennant Report-Jill Morsch

By the time the newsletter is out, finals for our 2018 Autumn Pennant will be completed. Congratulations and commiserations to all teams who competed in the finals. I trust that as always, matches were played in the right competitive Masters spirit and thanks and hospitality was extended to referees and markers who assisted on the night

A reminder that team submissions for the next pennant season must be received to our results Officer, Clara Edney, by **22**nd **June.** That way, we can complete gradings and pass them to Bryan Bird in order to get the fixture in place for next season.

The VMSA match and pennant committee have not organized a refereeing clinic for some time. In fact, we believe the last one was in 2008. We have decided to conduct one next season on Thursday July 26, which would normally be set down for the pennant co-ordinators meeting (one week prior to commencement of the new season). Like the last time we ran one, it is compulsory for at least 4 members of your team to attend this clinic and it will count as premiership points to your team. Any less than 4 team members will result in no premiership points to your team. The clinic will be conducted at the following venues – Westerfolds, Mulgrave and Squash Logic commencing at 7.30pm. Teams can choose which venue they wish to attend. Before you say "we have already attended a refereeing clinic with another pennant association" – it is irrelevant. It is compulsory to attend ours in order to receive premiership points. Please make sure you arrive early as you will be marked off as you enter the centre and this may take some time. Do not get someone else to mark you off as it will not be accepted – YOU must present yourself to the VMSA committee person who will record your attendance at your venue of choice. You must also stay for the entire presentation.

Teams will also be able to collect their fixture books on the night. You will also be receiving a questionnaire as to which scoring method you prefer for pennant going forward. The choice will be best of 5 games to 9 points, hand in/hand out or best of 5 games to 15 points, point a rally and to win by 2 clear points if scores reach 14 all. This is being done because we are hearing different views as to what point scoring system players prefer. In the past it was raised as a team question. This is your chance, as an individual, to put pen to paper and let us know once & for all what your preference is. From the answers we receive, the scoring preference of the majority will be implemented for the 2019 Autumn pennant season and beyond.

Once again, please mark **Thursday July 26** on your calendar for the compulsory refereeing clinic. We are making it as easy as possible to attend by using 3 venues. I can assure you, it won't be the same boring stuff, and you may learn something about new rule changes and refereeing decisions.
