Ascoli takes state title at Horsham

Melbourne player Mark Ascoli has captured his first division one title in the Victorian Masters Squash Association summer championships in Horsham. Ascoli was too strong for his Yarram opponent Mick Dyke in a thrilling final that had a large and appreciative crowd in awe of the speed and quality of the game. Ascoli, who recently returned to squash from a lengthy injury absence, defeated fellow Melbourne players Chye Lim and Gary McPyke on the way to the final.

The division two title was a local triumph with reigning Horsham champion Warren Frost winning a gruelling encounter. Frost had to dig deep and change his game style after dropping the first two sets in the final against Werribee's David Shay. He eventually found his range and power to take the next three sets and the title.

Donald player Julian Smith has been gaining recent media attention for his musical talents but his rhythm on the squash court was just as exceptional as he blasted his way to the division four title.

Horsham's Peter Miller won division seven, beating fellow Horsham player Robyn Creek in a heart stopping five-set final. Regular Masters player and Horsham life member Christine Chapple breezed through the division eight rounds to win the crown without dropping a set for the weekend. VMSA president Lou Morsch said the tournament was a great success. "The Horsham club did a wonderful job of hosting the tournament and everyone enjoyed their visit to the region," Mr Morsch said "We had very good sponsors and support from Horsham Rural City and we had plenty of people watching matches including Mayor Mark Radford," he said.

"I think everyone is keen to return to Horsham at some stage so I'm sure we will be back eventually."

1. The Victorian Championships is an **aged** event, you must be 35 years of age or over to enter. The Tournament will be conducted using triple plate or round robin draws depending on the number of entries received. Scoring will be PAR15 for all sections. All matches will be best of 5 games and every effort will be made to ensure that each entrant gets at least three matches.
2. Tournament Entry Fees are \$50 for Non-Members, \$40 for VMSA Financial Members and \$35 for VMSA Financial Members who have played 25+ tournaments. Early Bird rate offers a discounted entry fee for online entries received 2 weeks before the tournament start date.
3. Players may enter **ONE EVENT ONLY**.
4. All players must fulfil their obligations to other participants by competing in all matches set down for them.
5. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept, decline or re-grade any entries.
6. Notice of withdrawal and requests for refund must be made to the Tournament Director 7 days prior to the tournament start date. Any requests for refunds after this date are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
7. No claims whatsoever will be recognised should any player receive an injury whilst participating in the tournament.
8. First round matches will be available on our website www.vmsasquash.com.au from Wednesday 10th April 2019.
9. All players must report to the Tournament Control Desk **at least 30 MINUTES BEFORE** their next scheduled match. **It is your responsibility to check the draws for your next scheduled match time.**
10. All players are expected to be warmed up and ready to play as soon as the previous match is completed. Warm up time is 2 mins per side, 4 mins in total and 90 seconds between games.
11. All players are expected to mark or referee the match immediately following their own, or as directed by the Tournament Control.
12. Medal presentations will be at approximately 4:30pm Sunday followed by a complimentary supper.
13. A social get together, including complimentary supper will be held at the Bendigo Squash Club on Friday evening after the conclusion of the matches. **ALL WELCOME**
14. Snacks and refreshments will be available at the squash centre during the weekend.
15. A 2 course Dinner will be held on Saturday 13th April at The Foundry Hotel, 366 High St, Golden Square from 7:00pm. Drinks at bar prices. Cost: \$40 per person. There will be a live band after 9.30pm in another part of the venue. **PLEASE INCLUDE PAYMENT WITH YOUR ENTRY.**

- 2/ Juniors must be U23 as at 1/5/2019, Masters Men must be Over 35 and Women over 30
- 3/ Organisers will grade all players into suitable divisions once all entries have been received – please note that due to the nature of the event, numbers of entries accepted may be limited to a first come, first served basis – any players entering after maximum capacity has been reached will be notified as soon as possible.
- 4/ Players will compete in both singles and doubles with rounds being timed.
- 5/ Players can enter one team only and all players are guaranteed a minimum of four matches.
- 6/ Players will be required to referee where asked.
- 7/ ALL players, irrespective of age must wear approved protective eyewear for doubles and all junior players must wear protective eyewear for singles. Protective Eyewear will be available for use free of charge.
- 8/ The organiser's decisions are final and they also reserve the right to:
 - a) Refuse any entry and shall not be required to give any reason for such refusal
 - b) Regrade any player as necessary and disqualify any player not ready to begin his/her match punctually
