A Tassie Report— Ballarat 40th Anniversary Masters Tournament 11-13 February 2022

The Tassie contingent of George Kovaks, Elaine Boxhall, Gaye Mitchell, Graeme Bradfield, Wendy Ashley, Chris Bennett, Judy Fox, Annie Baker, Tony Smith and Darren Appleby took off with great excitement to the first Victorian masters tournament for some time. We also caught up with expats Adam Saddler and Leanne Haley. What a great trip! Sorry, if you weren't there, you missed out!

The Vic masters team led by Darren O'Neill did a fantastic job of organising. They went to some effort to invite all their life members and some ex-players to be part of the celebrations. All players received a 40th anniversary t-shirt. Covid meant the 40th anniversary was held in the 42nd year, after two cancellations. Steve Walton (previously Grays) with his new company InForm, was a major sponsor with the winners of all divisions receiving a racket and bag from InForm.

The Victorians were pretty excited to have a tournament after so much lockdown for them.

There were approximately 160 entries. Matches commenced about 7pm Friday night and the supper provided was at midnight following last matches. Generally, one match on the Saturday, then the dinner on Saturday night – again about 180 attending. The tough bit was to follow up on Sunday with two matches – all par 15 and best of 5!

The Vics expressed their appreciation at Tassie's effort to get a good contingent to the tournament and I think we will see some Vics reciprocate for our July Masters.

Considering the Victorians have spent so much time in lockdown, there was some excellent squash played. It was great to see the likes of Anthony Hill on court and appreciate his wonderful skills. I believe his highest ranking was No. 4 in the world at one stage and he only made it to the semis!

The Tassies were well-performed on and off the court. Jude & Annie, closely followed by Tony & Darren, held up the social side for us. There were 11 sections in the tournament. Chris Bennett and Annie Baker made it through to the semis (on opposite sides of the draw) in Division 9 with Judy Fox winning the special plate of that division. Wendy Ashley gave it her all in a tough Division 7. Tony Smith and Darren Appleby played a hard-fought five-setter in the final of Division 6 with Tony eventually being the winner. I think they will put Tony and Darren up a grade or two next tournament! Gaye Mitchell won Division 3 against the seedings.

The Division 1 final between Shahroze Khan and Peter Vaughan was an enthralling match with Peter Vaughan coming from behind to win a tight five-setter. Peter Vaughan defeated Anthony Hill to get to the final.

The Ballarat Squash Club has received council grants over the last few years since they held the Australian Masters in 2017 and the courts were in excellent condition. At least four of the courts had had their front walls covered with glass panels (Court Tec). They had put in new lights, air conditioning and solar panels on the roof. Walls had been painted and floors sanded.

Congratulations to Ballarat Squash Club, and in particular John Tobin who is a tireless worker for the club, for all the work they have done which makes the squash experience for players so much better.

Even though the temperature was over 37 degrees on two of the days the courts were pleasant to play on.

The Ballarat masters' tournament is an annual event and is one not to be missed – so plan to come to the next one this year on November 25-27





TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION


- 1. The Tournament will be a mixed graded event and will be conducted using triple plate or round robin draws depending on the number of entries received.

 Scoring will be PAR15 for all sections. All matches will be best of 5 games and every effort will be made to ensure that each entrant gets at least three matches.
- 2. All players must fulfil their obligations to other participants by competing in all matches set down for them.
- 3. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept, decline or re-grade any entries.
- 4. Notice of withdrawal and requests for refund must be made to the Tournament Director 7 days prior to the tournament start date. Any requests for refunds after this date are at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- 5. No claims whatsoever will be recognised should any player receive an injury whilst participating in the tournament.
- 6. First round matches will be available on our website www.vmsasquash.com.au from Wednesday 13th July 2022.
- 7. All players must report to the Tournament Control Desk at least 30 MINUTES BEFORE their next scheduled match.
- 8. All players are expected to be warmed up and ready to play as soon as the previous match is completed.
- 9. All players are expected to mark or referee the match immediately following their own, or as directed by the Tournament Control.
- ${\bf 10.}\ \ Trophy\ presentations\ will\ be\ at\ approximately\ 4:30pm\ Sunday\ followed\ by\ a\ complimentary\ supper.$
- 11. A social get together, including complimentary supper will be held at the Horsham Squash Club on Friday evening after the conclusion of the matches.
