DARREN O'NEILL AWARDED THE 2024 JUDITH GOADBY AWARD.







Darren joined the VMSA General Committee in 2009. Always quick to get involved, Darren was initially responsible for our newsletter and tournament poster mailouts. In those days, it was all done by mail so was quite a big job to print, envelope and mail out the newsletter to over 200 members. He then introduced us to the technological age of emailing our newsletters and doing tournament alerts via Mail Chimp.

Darren quickly took on other responsibilities as his influence grew. He has had a significant hand in much of the design of our uniforms, badges, stubby holders and towels. His background in painting and design has proved very beneficial for creating new merchandise and accessories.

His most significant contribution has been in his role as Tournament Director for the VMSA A role he undertook in 2019 after serving as understudy to Helena Morgan for the previous 2 years, including the Australians in Ballarat. Finding someone of the quality, understanding and dedication to the task was not something I expected to be easy to find, but Darren has embraced the role of Tournament Director and made it his own and commands great respect for the job he has undertaken. It is a credit to him that our tournament numbers remain strong and events run smoothly. Darren puts an enormous amount of time and effort into his role and was awarded the Victorian Judith Goadby Award in 2022.

Darren is also a keen supporter of the Australians having played over 15 Australians and has been a Team Co-ordinator for the Victorian Teams since 2011. He has also assisted other states with the design of lanyards for the Australians as well as the design of Australian shirts for the World Masters Squash Championships.

Congratulations Darren. You are a very worthy recipient of this prestigious award.

The Master's Philosophy

The Victorian Masters Squash Association (VMSA) was established in 1980 to encourage men and women aged 35 years and over to play Masters Pennant and Tournaments. Aimed specifically for those who still loved playing squash and socialising but were finding it harder to do so against the younger competitors who generally wanted to play and go or stay for supper but not provide a sufficient one. A few years after the VMSA was established it reduced the playing age for Women to 30 years and over in Pennant and Tournaments only. The qualifying age for tournaments such as the Victorian, Australian and World titles still remain at 35 years and over for both men and women.

The VMSA continues to run its own Pennant competition and Tournaments based on the 'Master's Philosophy' established over 40 years ago

TO PLAY COMPETIVELY BUT ALSO TO PLAY IN GOOD SPIRIT

So, if you have recently "retired" from playing, haven't played for a while and would like to do so again, or are just a beginner who also enjoys the social aspect of squash – why not come along and try the Master's approach. All you need is your racquet and some enthusiasm to compete whilst having a good time with good company.

The VMSA prides itself on its ability to provide a friendly, competitive way to play squash. You can be as competitive as you want as long as you play with good humour and commitment for the enjoyment of the game and of everyone present. This is what is known as **"the Master's Spirit"**.

- 9. All players are expected to mark or referee the match immediately following their own, or as directed by the Tournament Control.
