Tournament Conditions

- 1. Operation: The tournament will be conducted as both a 'Graded' and 'Gender' based event. Players will be guaranteed a minimum of three best of five set matches.
- 2. Past performances: These will be considered, together with current AMSA rankings or other rankings where appropriate.
- 3. Scoring: Point a rally (PAR) to fifteen or at fourteen all, then a clear two point margin is needed.
- 4. Balls: Double Yellow and Single Yellow Dot balls will be available. Note: You will not be obliged to use the ball left on the court from the previous match. In the event of disagreement between players, the Tournament Director will rule on the ball to be used.
- 5. Marking/Refereeing: All players are to mark/referee the following match on their court.
- 6. Entry: Players may enter one event only. Tournament organisers reserve the rightto cancel or combine events.
- 7. Registration: Each day, all players must register at the Woden or Weston Creek Control Desk at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled playing time.
- 8. Withdrawals/Refunds: No entry fees will be refunded for withdrawals notified after Tues 25 February 2025, unless the person withdrawing arranges a replacement.
- 9. Tournament Director: Karina Sommers, 0412 64 18 31.
- 10. Images of your participation may be included on the ACT Masters Website or Facebook page unless you specifically request that this not occur.
- 11. Illness: A player who has a pre-existing illness and is receiving ongoing treatment must provide medical evidence before the player will be able to participate in the tournament
- 12. Claims: No claims whatsoever will be recognised should any player receive an injury during the period of the tournament
