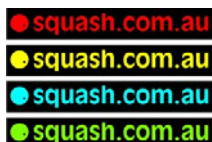

FINES & PENALTIES FOR YOUR ATTENTION

The following fines may be imposed for infringements:

- Falsifying Results: **Loss of points**
- Ineligible or unregistered player: **Loss of points**
- Incorrect playing order: **Loss of points**
- Individual walkovers: **Court costs for both players**
- Team walkovers: **\$100 plus all court costs**
- Failure to officiate as markers/ referees at finals: **\$160**
- Failure to attend compulsory meeting: **\$50**
- Withdrawal of nominated team after grading : **\$170**
- Non-payment of fine: **Penalty as determined by Pennant Committee**

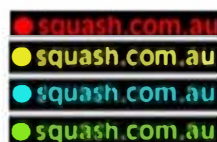
